April 6, 2023 - “A Man Called Otto”

A Man Called Otto tells the story of Otto Anderson (Tom Hanks), a grump who no longer sees purpose in his life following the loss of his wife. Otto is ready to end it all, but his plans are interrupted when a lively young family moves in next door and he meets his match in quick-witted Marisol. She challenges him to see life differently, leading to an unlikely friendship that turns his world around. April 13, 2023 - “Father Stu Reborn”

Based on a true story, Father Stu is an unflinchingly honest, funny and uplifting story about finding purpose in a most unexpected place. In this hilarious comedy, Doug (David Tennant) and Abi (Rosamund Pike) take their kids on a family vacation to visit his Grandfather (Billy Connolly).
