April 4, 2024 - “Golden Years”

Forced by Britain's pension crisis into a life of crime, formerly law-abiding retirees Arthur and Martha Goode bumble their way through a series of bank robberies. When their drinking buddies want in, they start pulling more daring heists, staying one step ahead of an old-time detective and his young sidekick. Bernard Hill and Virginia McKenna (Born Free) lead a stellar cast that also includes Alun Armstrong (New Tricks), Una Stubbs (Sherlock), Simon Callow (Four Weddings and a Funeral), and Sue Johnston (Downton Abbey). Maggie (Melissa McCarthy), a struggling single woman, moves to Brooklyn with her 12-year-old son, Oliver (Jaeden Lieberher). Having to work very long hours, she has no choice but to leave Oliver in the care of Vincent (Bill Murray), a bawdy misanthrope next door. Vincent takes Oliver along on his trips to the race track, strip club and dive bar, and an unlikely friendship is born.
